
## Parts supplied:







Pull the fixing bolt up so that it catches on the inner surface of the basin, and then tighten, but only tight enough to prevent the fitting sliding too much.




a: Locate the basin upside down against a wall. Insert the rail into the two fixing bolts – and push the rail so that the two plates touch the wall.




b: Pull the rail off the connectors, without moving the fittings, and fully tighten the connectors to the basin.
